J. Michael Small Receives LBF's Curtis R. Boisfontaine Trial Advocacy Award

J. Michael Small, an attorney in Alexandria, Louisiana has received the 2009 Louisiana Bar Foundation's (LBF) Curtis R. Boisfontaine Trial Advocacy Award. Mr. Small was selected for his long-standing devotion to excellence in trial practice and for upholding the standards of ethics and consideration for the courts, litigants and all counsel in his practice of the law. He received a plaque signifying the honor bestowed to him. In addition, the award carries a \$1,000 cash stipend, which the LBF donates to a non-profit law-related program or association providing services in the state of Louisiana in the honorees name. Mr. Small has selected CASA of Central LA to receive the stipend.
