

# Become a Kids' Chance Scholarship Sponsor

Megan's dad was killed when his 18-wheeler oil tanker truck flipped and caught fire. Blake's dad was robbed and murdered while on a test drive as a car salesman. Lori's mother was disabled when a large tree limb fell on her head at work as a meter maid. To Megan, Blake and Lori, funding their education beyond high school seemed next to impossible.

More than 100 Louisiana workers will die on the job this year. More than 45,000 will be injured, leaving half of them disabled. Families of these individuals face difficult challenges as they struggle to overcome the emotional and financial burden of these losses.

Since 2004 the Louisiana Bar Foundation (LBF) Kids' Chance Scholarship Program has awarded 68 scholarships totaling \$113,000 to deserving students to help ease the burden of paying for their education. Scholarships are awarded to dependent children of a worker killed or permanently and totally disabled in an accident compensable under a state or federal Workers' Compensation Act or law.
